Curriculum Overview

Islamic Studies (Grades K–6)

Goals:

- Understand basic beliefs of Islam
- Learn acts of worship (Salah, Sawm, etc.)
- Explore good manners, adab, and Islamic values
- Study stories of prophets and key Islamic figures

Each grade covers increasing levels of depth:

- **Kindergarten:** Who is Allah, Pillars of Islam, Festivals, Prophets
- **1st Grade:** Aqeedah, Ibadat, Angels, Manners
- **2nd Grade:** Names and attributes of Allah, Prophets, Pillars, Akhlaq
- **3rd Grade:** Belief, Sunnah, Islamic society, Kindness, Jinn
- **4th Grade:** Names of Allah, Early Islam in Arabia, Khalifahs, Fiqh of Salah
- **5th/6th Grade:** Tawheed, Major Battles, Global Islam, Islamic ethics

Qur'an Studies (Grades K–6)

Goals:

- Master recitation of Juz Amma
- Begin basic tajweed rules
- Memorize surahs with understanding
- Learn basic Arabic vocabulary through the Qur'an

Method:

- Students placed in levels based on ability (phonics → fluent recitation)
- Emphasis on both memorization and meaning
- Surahs taught include: Al-Fatihah, An-Nas, Al-Falaq, Al-Ikhlās, Al-Masad, An-Nasr, Al-Kawthar... up to An-Naba'

Seerah Curriculum (Grades K–6)

Goals:

- Know the life of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ
- Learn lessons from key events in his life
- Develop love, respect, and emulation for the Prophet ﷺ

Grade-Specific Focus:

- **1st Grade:** Prophet Muhammad ﷺ, Makkah, the Hijrah to Madinah, the Ansar, and his return to Makkah and passing.
- **2nd Grade:** Prophet's birth, early life, revelation, early Islam in Makkah.
- **3rd Grade:** Migration, Madinah life, battles, community building.
- **4th Grade:** The Sunnah as the best example, a day in the life of the Prophet ﷺ, and the Sahabah as role models.
- **5th/6th Grade:** Full chronological Seerah, including Isra/Mi'raj, key companions, and teachings.

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Student Expectations

- Attend regularly and arrive on time
- Come prepared with books and supplies
- Be respectful to teachers and classmates
- Participate in class and complete homework

Code of Conduct

- Students should dress modestly and behave respectfully.
- Cell phones should be put away during class.
- Disruptive behavior may result in parent meetings or disciplinary action.

- Review weekly lessons and help with memorization
- Encourage consistent attendance
